Financial Sanctions Notice

Democratic Republic of the Congo

Introduction

- Council Regulation (EC) 1183/2005 ("the Regulation") imposing financial sanctions against Democratic Republic of the Congo has been amended.
- Identifying information for the individuals and entities listed in the Annex to this Notice has been amended.

Notice summary (Full details are provided in the Annex to this Notice)

- 3. The following entries have been amended and are still subject to an asset freeze:
 - KAKWAVU Bukande Jerome (Group ID: 8707)
 - MAKENGA Sultani (Group ID: 12812)

 - CONGOMET TRADING HOUSE (Group ID: 9069)
 - MACHANGA LTD (Group ID: 9067)
 - TOUS POUR LA PAIX ET LE DEVELOPPEMENT (NGO) (Group ID: 8744)

What you must do

4. You must:

- check whether you maintain any accounts or hold any funds or economic resources for the persons set out in the Annex to this Notice;
- ii. freeze such accounts, and other funds or assets;
- iii. refrain from dealing with the funds or assets or making them available to such persons unless licensed by the Governor;
- iv. report any findings to the Governor, together with any additional information that would facilitate compliance with the Regulation;
- v. provide any information concerning the frozen assets of designated persons that the Governor may request. Information reported to the Governor may be passed on to other regulatory authorities or law enforcement.

- 5. Where a relevant institution has <u>already reported</u> details of accounts, other funds or economic resources held frozen for designated persons, <u>they are not required to report</u> these details again.
- Failure to comply with financial sanctions legislation or to seek to circumvent its provisions is a criminal offence.

Legislative details

- On 08 March 2017 Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 2017/396 ("the Amending Regulation") was published in the Official Journal of the European Union (O.J. L 60/41, 08.03.2017) by the Council of the European Union.
- The Amending Regulation amended Annex 1 to the Regulation with effect from 09 March 2017.
- The Amending Regulation reflects the decisions made on 12 January 2017 by the United Nations Security Council (UNSC) Committee established pursuant to Resolution 1533 (2004).
