Financial Sanctions Notice

ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida Organisations

Introduction

1. The United Nations Security Council's sanctions list has been updated.

Notice summary (Full details are provided in the Annex to this Notice)

- By virtue of the United Nations and European Union Financial Sanctions (Linking) Regulations 2017, one entry entry has been <u>added</u> to the consolidated list and is now subject to an asset freeze.
 - JAMA'A NUSRAT UL-ISLAM WA AL-MUSLIMIN (JNIM) (Group ID: 13712) (the "DP")

Legislative Details

- 3. On 4 October, the United Nations Security Council Committee established by Resolutions 1267 (1999), 1989 (2011) and 2253 (2015) concerning the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al Qaida Organisations approved the addition of 1 entry to its list of individuals and entities subject to an asset freeze.
- 4. Unless the DP is listed under EU Regulation 881/2002 by 03 November 2018, the asset freeze will cease to apply from 11:59 p.m. on 03 November 2018 until the date upon which the DP is listed by the EU.

What you must do

- 5. You must:
 - check whether you maintain any accounts or hold any funds or economic resources for the persons set out in the Annex to this Notice;

freeze such accounts, and other funds or economic resources; ii.

refrain from dealing with the funds or assets or making them available iii.

(directly or indirectly) to such persons unless licensed by the Governor;

report any findings to the Governor, together with any additional information iv.

that would facilitate compliance with the Regulation;

provide any information concerning the frozen assets of designated persons

that the Governor may request. Information reported to the Governor may be

passed on to other regulatory authorities or law enforcement.

6. Failure to comply with financial sanctions legislation or seeking to circumvent its

provisions is a criminal offence.
