Financial Sanctions Notice

Burma

Introduction

1. This notice is to issue a correction for 14 listings in the Burma regime. These amendments bring the consolidated list into line with Annex IV to Council Regulation (EU) No 401/2013 (“the regulation”).

Notice summary (Full details are provided in the Annex to this Notice)

2. 14 entries have been amended on the consolidated list and remain subject to an asset freeze.

What you must do

3. You must:
 - i. check whether you maintain any accounts or hold any funds or economic resources for the persons set out in the Annex to this Notice;
 - ii. freeze such accounts, and other funds or economic resources;
 - iii. refrain from dealing with the funds or assets or making them available (directly or indirectly) to such persons unless licensed by the Governor;
 - iv. report any findings to the Governor, together with any additional information that would facilitate compliance with the Regulation;

- v. provide any information concerning the frozen assets of designated persons that the Governor may request. Information reported to the Governor may be passed on to other regulatory authorities or law enforcement.
4. Where a relevant institution has already reported details of accounts, other funds or economic resources held frozen for designated persons, they are not required to report these details again.
5. Failure to comply with financial sanctions legislation or to seek to circumvent its provisions is a criminal offence.

2. **CHAY, Kyaw**

Title: Corporal **Other Information:** *Gender: male. Kyaw Chay is A Corporal in the Border Guard Police (BGP). He was formerly based in Zay Di Pyin and was the Commanding Officer of the BGP base in Zay Di Pyin in the period around 25 August 2017. Oversaw military operations carried out in Shan State in 2016 and early 2017. Responsible for unlawful killings, forced detention and destruction of villages in Shan State.* **Listed on:** 24/12/2018 **Last Updated:** ~~24/12/2018~~ 11/08/2020 **Group ID:** 13735.

4. **KYAW, Ba**

Title: Staff Sergeant **Other Information:** *Gender: male. Ba Kyaw is A Staff Sergeant in the 564th Light Infantry Battalion (LIB) of the Myanmar Armed Forces (Tatmadaw). Committed atrocities and serious human rights violations against the Rohingya population in Rakhine State in the second half of 2017. Identified as one of the key perpetrators of the Maung Nu massacre on 27 August 2017.* **Listed on:** 24/12/2018 **Last Updated:** ~~24/12/2018~~ 11/08/2020 **Group ID:** 13733.

5. **LWIN, Thura San**

Position: Commander of the 8th Security Police Battalion **Other Information:** Gender: male. Responsible for unlawful killings and the systematic burning of Rohingya houses and buildings. 9. SOE, Maung Maung

Major General Maung Maung See was the Commander of the Western Command of the Myanmar Armed Forces (Tatmadaw) from October 2016 to 10 November 2017. Oversaw the military operations in Rakhine State. Responsible for unlawful killings, sexual violence and systematic burning of Rohingya houses and buildings. **Listed on:** 26/06/2018 **Last Updated:** 26/06/2018-11/08/2020 **Group ID:** 13682.

10. SOE, Khin Maung

Title: Brigadier General **DOB:** --/--/1972. **Position:** Commander of the Military Operation Command 15, also sometimes known as the 15th Light Infantry Division, of the Myanmar Armed Forces (Tatmadaw), under which Infantry Battalion No 564 falls. **Other Information:** Gender: male. Battalion No 564 falls under Military Operation Command 15, also sometimes known as the 15th Light Infantry Division. Responsible for unlawful killings, sexual violence and the systematic burning of Rohingya houses and buildings. **Listed on:** 26/06/2018 **Last Updated:** 04/05/2019-11/08/2020 **Group ID:** 13689.

11. SWE, NyiNyi

Title: Major General **Position:** Commander of the South-western Command of the Myanmar Armed Services **Other Information:** Gender: male. In that capacity, he is responsible for the atrocities and serious human rights violations committed in Kachin State from May 2016 to April 2018, until his appointment as Commander of the South-western Command. Responsible for the ill-treatment of civilians and obstructing the provision of humanitarian assistance to civilians in need in Kachin state, including the blocking of food transports. **Listed on:** 24/12/2018 **Last Updated:** 24/12/2018-11/08/2020 **Group ID:** 13739.

12. THU, Aung Myo

Gender: male. Oversaw military operations carried out in Rakhine State in 2017. 13. WIN, ThantZaw
