Terrorism and Terrorist Financing

Introduction

 Two designations have been renewed under the Terrorist Asset-Freezing etc. Act 2010 (TAFA).

The reason for this Notice

- The Office of Financial Sanctions Implementation (OFSI), part of HM Treasury, has renewed the final designation of the following entities with effect from Wednesday 4th November 2020.
 - Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine (PFLP) (Group ID: 7401)
 - Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command (PFLP-GC) (Group ID: 7399)
- This means that the entities listed above are therefore designated persons for the purposes of TAFA and continue to be subject to the financial sanctions imposed by it.

What you must do:

4. You must:

- check whether you hold any accounts, funds or economic resources for, or provide financial services to, the persons set out in the Annex to this Notice;
- ii. freeze such accounts or other funds;
- iii. suspend the provision of any financial services to that person;

- vii. refrain from dealing with such funds or making them available to such persons unless licensed by the Governor.
- viii. report any findings to the Governor, together with any additional information that would facilitate compliance with TAFA.
- ix. provide any information concerning the frozen assets of designated persons that the Governor may request. Information reported to the Governor may be passed on to other regulatory authorities or law enforcement.
- 12. If you have <u>already reported</u> details of accounts held frozen for designated persons, <u>you are not required to report these details again.</u>
- 13. Failure to comply with financial sanctions legislation is a criminal offence.
- 14. Some dealings with funds and economic resources that would otherwise contravene TAFA can be licensed by OFSI. You can find out about applying for a licence as well as information about General Licences in OFSI's Guide to Financial Sanctions:

Can I challenge a Designation?

- 15. If you are the designated person, you may appeal to the High Court or, in Scotland, the Court of Session, under section 26 of TAFA, any decision of OFSI to make or vary, or not to vary or revoke, an interim or final designation, or to renew a final designation.
- 16. If you are the designated person or a person affected by a decision of OFSI (other than decisions to which section 26 applies) you may apply to the High Court or, in Scotland, the Court of Session, for the decision to be set aside.
