Directions from Financial Services Commission

Please be informed that 1 entry has been varied under the Russia financial sanctions regime.

On 24th June 2026, the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office updated the UK Sanctions List on Gov.Uk. This list provides details of those entries designated under regulations made under the Sanctions Act.

1 entry has been varied under the Russia financial sanctions regime and remains subject to an asset freeze.

The consolidated list of asset freeze targets has been updated to reflect these changes.

Regime: Russia

On 24 June 2026 the Foreign, Commonwealth and Development Office updated the UK Sanctions List on GOV.UK with the following 1 variation.

Variations

A variation is a change to a designation following an official decision-making process. Deleted information appears in strikethrough and in red. Newly added information is underlined and highlighted in yellow.

The following entry has been varied and is still subject to the sanctions listed:

1. Individual: Mikhail Maratovic FRIDMAN

Regime name: The Russia (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019

Sanctions imposed: Asset freeze, Travel Ban, Trust Services Sanctions, Director Disqualification Sanction, Transport sanctions: see "Other information"

Other information: Transport sanctions: ships owned, controlled, chartered or operated by the individual are prohibited from entering a port in the UK; may be given a movement or a port entry direction, can be detained, and will be refused permission to register on the UK Ship Register or have its existing registration terminated. An aircraft owned, chartered or operated by the individual is prohibited from overflying or landing in the UK, may be given a movement direction, can be detained or moved to a specified airport, and will be refused permission to register on the CAA Aircraft Register or have its existing registration terminated. Prohibition of technical assistance relating to aircraft and ships: a prohibition on the provision of technical assistance relating to aircraft or ships will prevent a person from directly or indirectly providing technical assistance to, or for the benefit of, the designated person, where that technical assistance relates to an aircraft or ship. The Director Disqualification Sanction was imposed on 09/04/2025.

UK statement of reasons: The Secretary of State as reasonable grounds to suspect that Mikhail Maratovich FRIDMAN is an "involved person" under the Russia (Sanctions) (EU Exit) Regulations 2019 (the "Russia Regulations") on the basis of the following grounds: (1) FRIDMAN is and/or has been involved in obtaining a benefit from or supporting the Government of Russia by working as a director or equivalent of Alfa Group, a person carrying on business in a sector of strategic significance to the Government of Russia, namely the Russian financial services sector; (2) FRIDMAN has been involved in obtaining a benefit from or supporting the Government of Russia by working as a director or equivalent of ABH Holdings S.A., an entity carrying on business in a sector of strategic significance to the Government of Russia, namely the Russian financial services sector; (3) FRIDMAN has been involved in obtaining a benefit from or supporting the Government of Russia by working as a director or equivalent of Alfa-Bank Russia, an entity carrying on business in a sector of strategic significance to the Government of Russia, namely the Russian financial services sector; (4) FRIDMAN has been involved in obtaining a benefit from or supporting the Government of Russia by working as a director or equivalent of Alfa-Bank Russia, an entity carrying on business of economic significance to the Government of Russia; (5) FRIDMAN is and/or has been involved in obtaining a benefit from or supporting the Government of Russia by carrying on business in a sector of strategic significance to the Government of Russia, namely the Russian financial services sector; (6) FRIDMAN is associated with a person who is or has been so involved, namely PetrAVEN.

Asset freeze: what you must do

If you know or have 'reasonable cause to suspect' that you are in possession or control of, or are otherwise dealing with, the funds or economic resources of a designated person you must:

1. freeze them
2. not deal with them or make them available to, or for the benefit of, the designated person, unless there is an exception in the legislation that you can rely on or you have a licence from OFSI
3. [report any findings to OFSI](#)

If you are a [relevant firm](#) you have obligations under financial sanctions.

Information received by OFSI may be disclosed to third parties in accordance with provisions set out in the Information and record-keeping section of the regulations and in compliance with applicable data protection laws.

Making available: what is prohibited

Making funds or economic resources available to a designated individual or entity subject to an asset freeze is prohibited for everyone that must comply with UK sanctions. See the [starter guide to UK sanctions](#) for more details.

Enforcement and penalties

Failure to comply with UK financial sanctions legislation or to seek to circumvent its provisions may be a criminal offence.
